

FOREST-GROWN COFFEE BY SLOW!

Dedicated farmers

Slow's team in Laos works directly with local farmers to deliver the coffee you are now enjoying.

The farmers are paid a fair living wage, of which 40% is pre-paid four months before the harvest to balance their income, further improving their livelihood.



Nature positive

Coffee grown in an agroforest pulls more CO₂ out of the atmosphere than is emitted in the rest of the coffee value chain.

At the same time, the trees are a habitat for biodiversity to thrive. This way, we are bringing back nature together!



Direct trade

Slow has disrupted the traditional coffee value chain. We work directly with the farmers, eliminating up to 15 middlemen.

This ensures complete transparency every step of the way, from crop to cup - and ensures that farmers doing the job receive the full payment, not just a minor share.



Forest-grown

Our coffee is grown shaded by trees and without pesticides or chemical fertilisers.

Slow's forest-grown coffee preserves and regenerates local biodiversity, allowing plants, insects, birds- and wildlife to thrive.

Our local team counts and identifies the trees on every farm delivering Slow coffee, directly measuring our impact on nature.



Great taste

Slow coffee matures at nature's pace and is hand-picked only when ripe. The result is high-quality, single-origin, 100% Arabica coffee, carefully roasted for a full-bodied, great taste.
